Discussion about the Sept 17th Community Meal. There is traditionally a candidate forum during this meal. We decided to have a discussion on the jail issue. Community Garden at OSLC: Jim moved and Ray seconded to reimburse the church \$85 for rental of the auger to build the fence. Motion passed. Saturday, Sept 30th there will be a work party with Western students "Do Good in the Neighborhood" event.

John Hymas spoke to on-going care of our street trees. There is a great need to water through the summer. One water bag was stolen. Board approved reimbursing John \$59 for three new water bags and debris removal. Trees are also in need of pruning.

D-ADU pilot project: We are waiting for news from the Planning Department regarding upcoming hearing and meeting dates.

Southside Summer Cookout will be Sunday, August 20th from 4:30-6:30pm in the OSLC parking lot. Food, beer, music, bounce house and more. Board approved \$100 to cover the cost of the bounce house. Volunteers are needed on Saturday 10-12pm for food prep and Sunday to set-up 2-4:30, serve during the event and clean up after 6:30pm.
